As custodians of our exceptional natural environment we have a responsibility to protect, preserve and enhance what we have inherited and ensure we take action against blots on the landscape and threats to sustainability.

We can act to:

- Avoid disturbance to sensitive areas causing damage to habitats and loss of species
- Avoid pollution of our waterways
- Avoid light pollution
- Encourage conservation of water and alternative energy sources
- Encourage good woodland management.
- Discourage intensive agricultural practices which cause direct loss of species diversity.
- Remove and/or prevent negative visual impacts on our landscape caused by inappropriate developments,
- Control litter and waste disposal
- Control excessive deer and wild boar numbers
- Eliminate new invasive plants and animals out-competing native species and spreading potentially serious diseases such as Ash Die back and Sudden Oak Disease
